Bird Ballad Box



Simple 2" x 2" Bird Ballad box for gift giving.

Supplies needed:

- Blushing Bride 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [131198]
- Pretty Peacock 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [150880]
- Bird Ballad Designer Series Paper [149592]
- Pearl Basic Jewels [144219]
- Stampin' Dimensionals [104430]
- trimmer
- Scalloped Tag Topper Punch [133324]
- Metallic Brads [146929]
- Tear & Tape Adhesive [138995]
- Paper Snips [103579]

Project Recipe:

1. Cut Blushing Bride Cardstock (CS) 4" x 7".
Score the long side at 1", 3", 4" and 6".
Score the short side at 1" and 3".
2. Cut tabs as shown in picture. Use the Scalloped Tag Topper on the outer front flap. Corner round the side flaps.

3. Use Tear & Tape on the flaps and fold box together. Here's a Facebook Live video showing how to put another version of this box together. <https://www.facebook.com/StampingMom/videos/422154995405658/>
4. Cut Pretty Peacock CS at 1-7/8 to layer on the top of the box.
5. Cut Bird Ballad DSP at 1-11/16 to layer on top of the Pretty Peacock.
6. Use Paper Snips to cut another flower and leaves from the Bird Ballad Designer Series Paper (DSP) and pop up on a Stampin' Dimensional. Add pearls.
7. Fold front flap down and mark with pencil where the brad should go. Add a brad and hook front flap in place.
