2020 Calendar



Make this fun and easy calendar using products from the Stampin' Up Follow Your Art Suite. The frame is from IKEA.

Supplies needed:

- Follow Your Art Designer Series Paper [149489]
- Crafting Forever Cling-Mount Stamp Set [151231]
- Stitched Shapes Dies [145372]
- Layering Circles Dies [141705]
- Coastal Cabana 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [131297]
- Calypso Coral 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [122925]
- Whisper White 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [100730]
- Silver Stampin' Emboss Powder [109131]
- Embossing Buddy [103083]
- Versamark Pad [102283]
- Heat Tool (Us And Canada) [129053]
- Mango Melody Dark Stampin' Blends [147944]
- Paper Snips [103579]
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue [110755]
- Stampin' Dimensionals [104430]

Project Recipe:

1. The Tolsby 4" x 6" frame is \$1 from IKEA. The calendar is \$3 for 10 calendars from Taylored Expressions.
2. Cut 4" x 6" Follow Your Art Designer Series Paper (DSP) As your adding the elements, be aware that only 3-1/2" x 5" show and there is a 1/2" on all sides covered by the frame.

3. Stamp "Do something creative every day," from the Crafting Fun stamp set with Versamark on a scrap of Coastal Cabana. Sprinkle with Silver Stampin Emboss powder and heat with Heat Tool. Run through the Big Shot with the third largest Stitched Circle die.

4. Stamp the scissors from the Crafting Fun stamp set with Versamark on a scrap of Whisper White CS. Sprinkle with Silver Stampin Emboss powder and heat with Heat Tool. Use Paper Snips to cut around the scissors. Color handles with the dark Mango Melody Stampin' Blend.

5. Attach the scissors and the circle on to the DSP. I put the scissors so they look like they're cutting the circle.

6. Cut 2-1/2 x 3-1/4 Calypso Coral and attach the calendar to the center. Attach to the outside of the plastic piece so the calendar months can be torn off.
