# #sharesunshine



**U**se Stampin' Up's digital stamp set, #sharesunshine, available until June 2, 2020 to make this cute and simple card. No stamping required!

## Supplies needed:

- Stitched Shapes Dies [152323]
- Layering Circles Dies [151770]
- Stitched Rectangle Dies [148551]
- See A Silhouette Designer Series Paper [149443]
- Poppy Parade 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [119793]
- Poppy Parade Dark Stampin' Blends Marker [146879]
- Old Olive 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [100702]
- Old Olive Dark Stampin' Blends Marker [144573]
- Whisper White 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [100730]
- Stampin' Dimensionals [104430]
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue [110755]

## Project Recipe:

1. Cut 4-1/4" x 11" Poppy Parade Cardstock (CS) scored at 5-1/2" to form card base.
2. Cut 4" x 5-1/4" Old Olive CS and adhere to the front of the card.
3. Cut 3-3/4" x 5" See A Silhouette Designer Series Paper (DSP) and adhere to Old Olive layer.
4. I printed all the sentiments and pictures from the Stampin' Up #sharesunshine digital stamp set on Whisper White CS. Run picture of martini glass from the digital stamp set through the die cutting machine with the largest Stitched

- Shape circle die. Run a scrap of Old Olive CS through die cutting machine with the largest Scallop Circle die. Pop picture layer up on Stampin' Dimensionals and adhere to Old Olive layer.
5. Cut sentiment from the same digital stamp set. Adhere to DSP layer. Adhere circle over the edge of the sentiment strip.
  6. Inside the card add a 4" x 5-1/4" Old Olive layer. Add a 3-3/4" x 5" Whisper White layer.
  7. Run a scrap of Poppy Parade CS through die cutting machine with a Stitched Rectangle die. Layer the cut sentiment from the same digital stamp set on top.
