Project Recipe:

1. Here are the directions for the basic Vertical Joy Fold card. You can look in the supplies at what I used to make this particular card. I made a video showing many different Joy Fold cards. <https://youtu.be/GminDulZ7fg>

To make the base card, cut Cardstock (CS) 4-1/4" x 8-1/4" scored at 5-1/2" If you want to put a layer on it is 4" x 5-1/4". The layer on the bottom flap is 2-1/2" x 4". Both of these layers are optional.

2. The smaller inside card is 3-1/4" x 8-1/2" scored at 4-1/4". The layer for outside and inside of this card is 3" x 4".
3. If you want to make a pocket for a gift card, skip the inside layer in the step above and do this instead. Cut a piece of DSP 2-3/4" x 3". Use a 1-1/4" circle punch to cut a divot out so it's easier to get the gift card out. Adhere to the inside of the smaller card. Make sure the adhesive is only around the edges so there's room to slip the gift card in.
4. Decorate and embellish however you choose. This picture shows how the card goes together.
